SAE Plan – Description (5pts)	Describes interest in this area, estimates dates of involvement, related courses, and generally describes the project. SAE Plan – Time (5pts)	Describes commitment of time including planning and working in the project. Also, how time is planned to be balanced to other commitments. (5 pts)	Includes general ideas of time, but lacks clarity and needs minor revisions. (4-3 pts)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (2-0 pts)	
SAE Plan – Financial Investment (5pts)	Describes estimated cost to purchase the project and related expenses, sources of funds, estimated income and any “non- cash” expenses related to the project. (5 pts)	Includes general ideas, but lacks details about financial needs or sources of funding for the project and needs minor revisions. (4-3 pts)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (2-0 pts)

SAE Budget (5pts)	Describes an appropriate financial estimate for the project. (5 pts)	Has information, but lacks details and needs revisions. (4-3 pts)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (2-0 pts)	
SAE Pictures (15pts)	SAE pictures illustrate responsibility and illustrate working in their project. Also, the captions describe the photo and are well written. (15 -11pts)	SAE pictures are provided, but lack quality and/or captions need editing. Minor revisions are needed. (10-6 pts)	Photos are missing, poor quality or errors exist in captions. Major revisions are needed (5-0 pts).	
SAE Journals (15pts)	SAE Journals represent the complete timeframe of the project, illustrate consistent engagement and are well written. (15 -11 pts)	SAE Journals represent the complete timeframe of the project, but are not consistent and need editing. (10-6 pts)	Missing or lacks information and needs major revisions. (5-0 pts)	
SAE Finances & Annual Income Statement (15pts)	SAE finance details represent the complete timeframe of the project, illustrate appropriate finances for the scope/size of the project and the annual income statement is appropriate for the project. (15 -11 pts)	SAE finance details lack consistency for the time frame of the project or financial results (detail or annual income statement) are not complete. (10-6 pts)	Financials are missing information and need major editing. (5-0 pts)
